Summer Potato Salad

Ingredients:

3 lbs red potatoes, boiled, quartered and cooled	3/4 c mayonnaise
3-5 eggs, hard-boiled and chopped	1-2 tbsp mustard
1/4 c pickles, diced	Sliced cucumbers and tomatoes for garnish
1 small red onion, chopped	1/2 tsp paprika
1/2 c celery, chopped	Salt and pepper to taste

Preparation:

Combine potatoes, eggs, onion, pickles and celery. Stir in mayonnaise & mustard a little at a time until the flavor is right. Add salt and pepper to taste. Top with thinly sliced tomatoes and cucumber, if desired. Sprinkle paprika on top. Serves 6-8.
