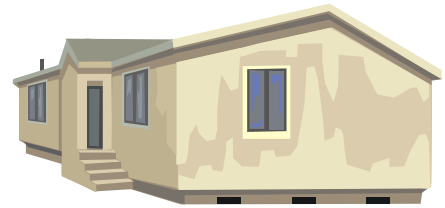


Imagine you are going to move to a new house, and you can only take ten things with you. What would they be and why?

Moving? Things to Do:

1. Make a file for all your 'to do lists,' notes, moving papers and receipts.
2. Shop around if you're hiring a moving company or need storage.
3. Transfer your child's school records if you are changing schools.
4. Buy any packing supplies you need.
5. Complete any needed home repairs.
6. Contact your utility and service companies to disconnect service, and if needed, reconnect service for your new home.
7. Make all of your travel plans.
8. Decide what needs to travel with you. Keep it separated.
9. Begin packing items outside and in the basement/ garage/ shed.
10. Start cleaning. Find new homes for what you can't take with you.
11. Cancel any home subscriptions you have.
12. Keep packing! Label each box with what's inside, where it goes and any special instructions.
13. Safely dispose of all hazardous household chemicals.
14. Start eating items in your freezer and pantry.
15. On moving day, pack up any last items like bedding and towels. Do any last minute cleaning. Take one last look around, shut off all lights, say good-bye and lock your doors for the last time. You did it! Now it's time to move in!



Don't forget to make a list of people you need to notify of your change of address. Tell your tutor and LVCC (556-0313) that you are moving. Complete a driver's license change of address form. Get the moving packet at the post office to change your address and forward your mail.
